OPERATIONS REPORT
12h to 8h 16 Nov. 1918.

1. Hostile situation at the beginning of the day - unchanged.
2. Information received of enemy during the day - Returned prisoner of war states that troops are looting and in many cases out of control of their officers, the latter being shot in an attempt to quiet the troops. He also stated that they are throwing away their small arms, and taking their artillery with them.
- 3 - Hostile movements, changes and conduct during the day - N.T.R.
- 4 - Map illustrating the above - N.T.R.
5. Own situation at the beginning of the day - Unchanged
6. Own movements, changes and conduct during the day - Regimental P.C. moved from vicinity of CREPION to 157th Brigade Hdqs. with P. C. at 29.1 - 3.9 arriving at 15h., then acting adjutant remaining at former P. C.
7. Information of neighboring units - N.T.R.
8. Orders received - Memorandum G-2 regarding returned Prisoners of War.
9. Action during the day and orders received and issued - N.T.R.
- 10 Results of action both own and enemy - N.T.R.
11. Maps illustrating the above - N.T.R.
12. Estimate of situation - unchanged.
13. Plans for the future - dependent upon orders.
14. Morale - good. Supplies - good.
