Since writing last message have had a definite report from the front. The front is now as follows: 09.9-83.5; 10.0-83.2; 11.9-83.3; 11.3-83.0. This information was obtained from the Tank Commander of the small tanks, who is now back, and from the two leading battalions of the 314th Inf. The advance has been stopped. It appears also to be held up on right and left divisions who are still behind us. The enemy fortification at Madelaine Swamps consists of anti-tank guns, machine guns renders imperative further artillery preparation before advance can be resumed. Bois de Cune is
