In 1882 Cossack armies were given standardized regimental states of either 4 or 6 "hundreds" from 4 hundreds (these states were retained into the First World War):

1. Regiments with 6 hundreds (Don, Kuban, Terek, Astrakhan, Ural, Orenburg and Siberian Cossack armies) contained: 4 field-officer, 4 esauls (captain), 7 sotniks (1st lieutenant), 8 khorunzihs (2nd lieutenant), 6 cavalries sergeant-major, 80 elder and younger uriadniks (sergeants), 750 private soldier, 13 trumpeters (of all: 872 men).  
2. Regiments with 4 hundreds (Semirechenskoje, Zabajkal'skoje, Amur and Ussurijskoje Cossack armies) contained: 3 field officer, 3 esauls, 5 sotniks, 6 khorunzihs, 4 cavalry sergeant major, 54 elder and younger uriadniks, 500 private soldier, 9 trumpeters (of all: 584 men).
